- 1. The ACWSA Board was called to order by Commander Pat Kaboskey around 9 a.m. on Sunday, September 19 at the Bristol range. Member units present: 1 USSS, 2 Wis, 6 Wis, 10 IL, 15 Wis, 56 VA, and 66 NC.
- 2. The board voted by a wide margin to adopt the "Kepis" design for the official ACWSA logo. A copy in .pdf format is attached to this note. Thanks go to David Altman for submitting the winning design, and to everyone who submitted one for consideration.

- 5. On August 27-28 there is a huge shooting sports event near Oshkosh. Commander Kaboskey would like to have an ACWSA booth and possibly a shooting demonstration at the event. The board unanimously authorized the expenditure of \$250 for a booth rental.
- 6. Awards. With the 2nd place musket trophy full and the 1st place trophy nearing capacity the board voted to retire them, and replace them with plaques similar to the Revolver and Musket-Carbine-Revolver awards. The board also voted to purchase third place plaques for Musket and Carbine team. The 1st place musket trophy will be returned to the 46th Illinois, and the 2nd place trophy returned to the family of Frank Matuszek, who originally donated them to the CWSA.
